When a dog or cat reaches the age of seven, they are entering the senior stage of life. This is the time when pets are more likely to start experiencing some changes in their health that can compromise their quality of life. Often these changes are not visible in a routine examination or in their daily activities at home. However, with some simple lab testing, we can detect the changes at an early stage and implement therapies that can address these issues. This can contribute to a happier and longer life for your friend.

We recommend a yearly blood panel, which includes a CBC (checks for anemia, infection, inflammation, etc.) and chemistry panel (checks for kidney disease, liver disease, diabetes, etc.) for all animals over the age of 7.
